Label Guidance on Seaweed Products: Seaweed extracts companies must declare on their labels the product's origin, describe the ingredients' source, and offer a marker compound (chosen by the company) to demonstrate the "authenticity" of the substance.

For example, Brazil uses alginic acid content, while other countries use mannitol content. Companies may choose other biomarkers, such as fucoidan or eckol, but regardless of the marker compound chosen, an approved method must be submitted in the composition portion of this application.

For example, a seaweed label derived from the statement and guaranteed analysis may appear:

"Contains Aquatic Plant Extract derived from Ascophyllum nodosum and Potassium Hydroxide"

Guaranteed Content: Mannitol 1%
